Discarded baling twine can now be recycled into pellets that are used in the manufacturing of plastic items. The pelletizer equipment is located at Waste-Not Recycling in Johnstown, Colorado. \$0.10/ pound will be paid for delivered twine, making it possible for FFA and 4-H groups to collect twine as a fund raiser and/or a school based Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE).



Twine recycling cleans up the environment and protects livestock and wildlife. Your group's participation in this program is also providing a community service, as we partner to build state-wide twine recycling.
