

***WHY RECYCLE BALING TWINE?***

**Plastic baling twine contributes to wildlife mortality when birds become entangled and die. When other wildlife or livestock eat the twine it forms a ball in their gut and they die unless it is surgically removed.**



**Several million pounds of this twine are discarded annually into local landfills even though it is 100% recyclable.**



***HOW CAN YOU RECYCLE BALING TWINE?***

**Used twine can be piled up outside and brought to any collection site either as loose twine or in bags.**



**Please remove any trash or chunks of hay from the twine before bringing it to a collection site.**
